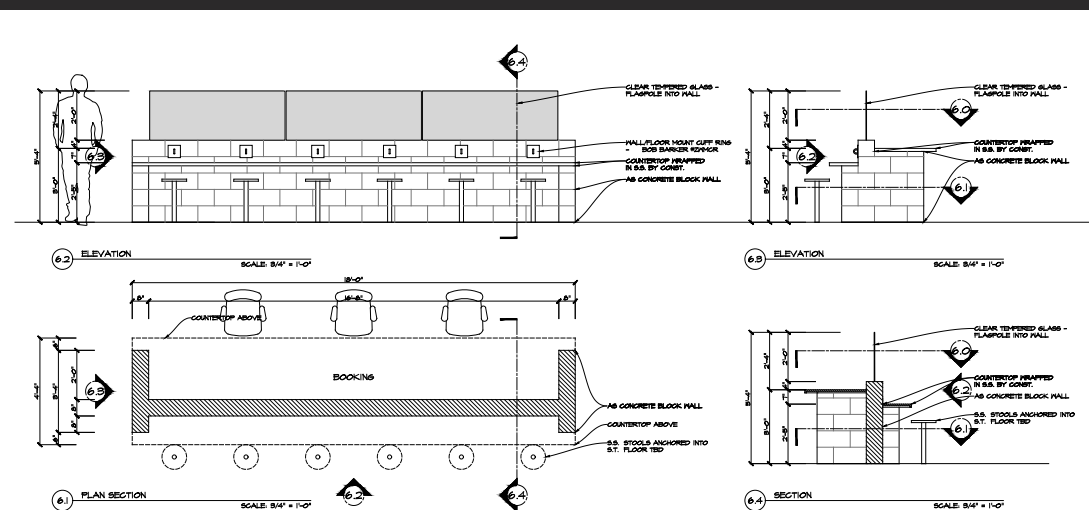

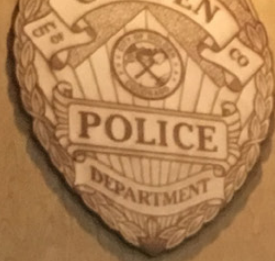

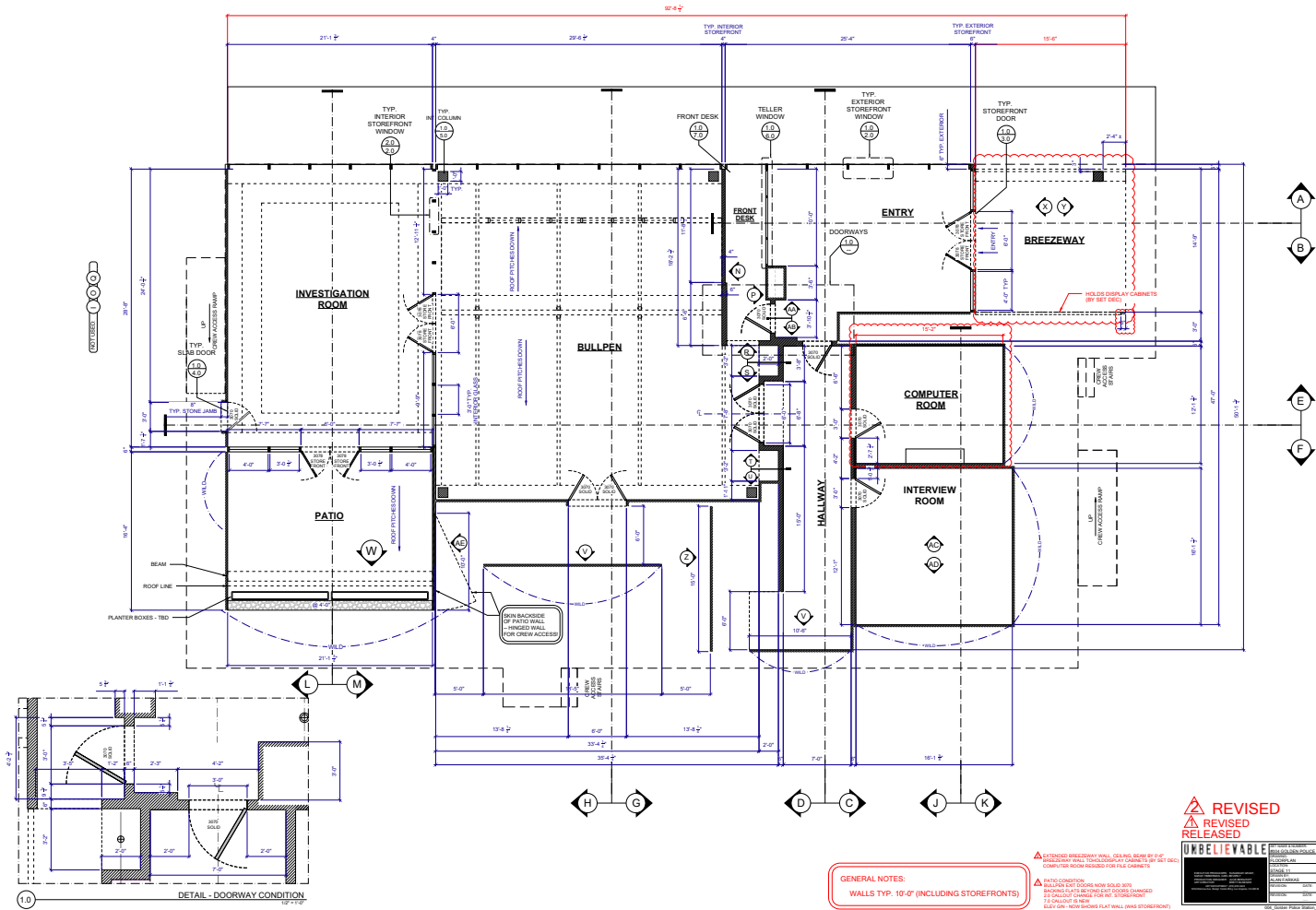
HISTORY

- Golden is founded
- "Golden City" incorporated
- 1874 The official police department established
- 1879 Golden City is changed to "Golden" when population reaches 1,000
- 1911 An ordinance is passed to prohibit speed on highways for automobiles
- 1915 City Council issues the police badge as a symbol of authority
- 1924 Officers are appointed to various positions
- 1926 Motorcycles are added to the police fleet
- 1929 The speed limit is lowered to 15 mph
- 1930 Speed limit is increased to 20 mph
- 1931 Stop signs are installed and a road sign is placed over the main building to signify crime prevention
- 1934 Officers are trained in a formal setting
- 1961 Two police cadets are added to the City's roster to promote leadership and are sworn to serve as a law enforcer
