**HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT BREAKS ALIEN INVASION STORY: EXPOSES MILITARY COVER-UP**

Officials of the United States government continue to dispute an account printed in Thursday's edition of the Coldcreek High Weekly Bobcat describing the appearance of a physics-defying flying vessel above the Arid Plains town of Asteroid City last week; and the removal of a state monument (specifically a cantaloupe size- and shaped-meteorite of unknown astral origin and composition) by an unidentified interplanetary voyager traveling therein. Representatives of local

tribal councils were quick to point out the object's historical importance and prominent use in spiritual rituals and meteorological ceremonies -- specifically the "Moon-Fire Rain-Dance" which is performed at the festival solstice in years of precipitation drought. Photographic evidence supports cub reporter Ricky Cho's claims, detailed in his article. French Press International photographer Augie Steenbeck, witness to the event,

supplied a print of the image to the agency, perhaps surreptitiously. It has been reproduced in publications around the globe to significant acclaim in both journalistic and quote-unquote "artistic" circles. Cho cites a local mechanic's portrait of the incident: "He sort of elevated himself down from the hovering. I guess you call it, flying saucer. He looked a little worried, honestly. 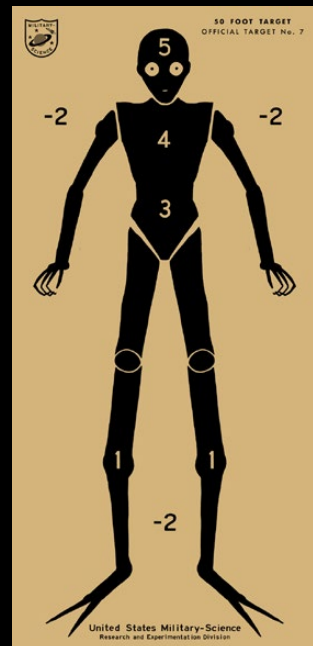

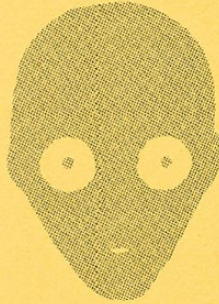
