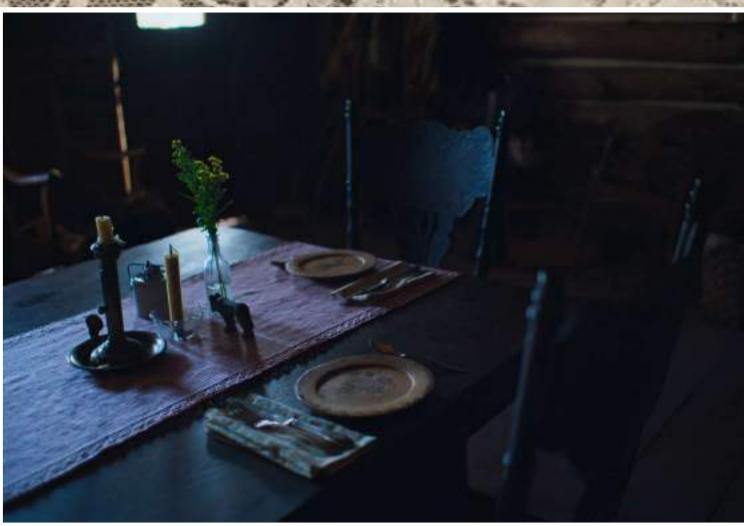




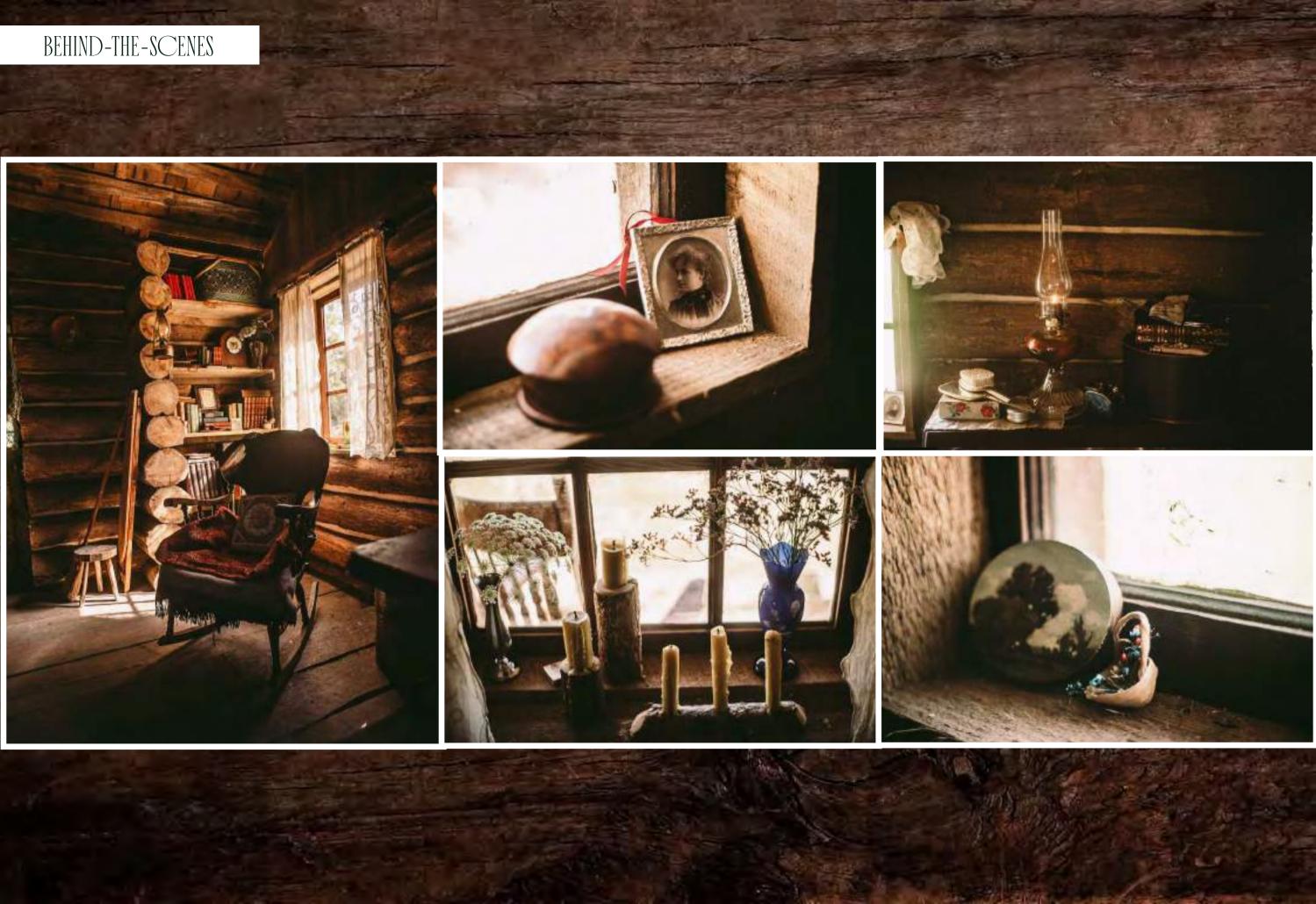












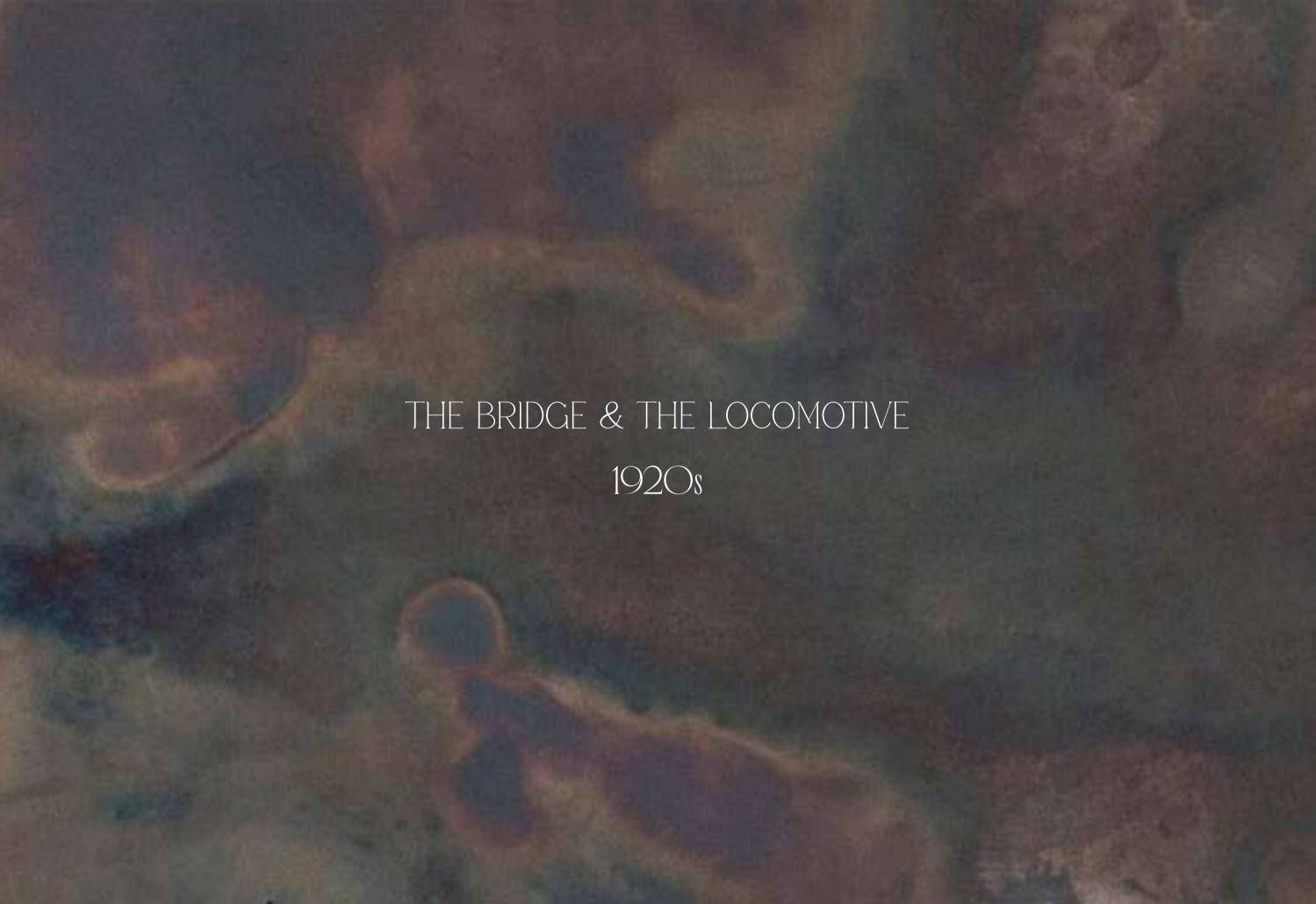




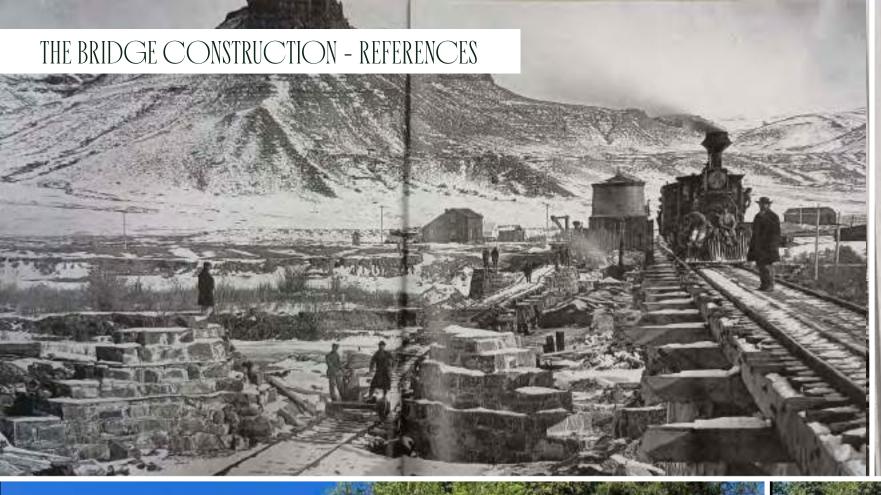






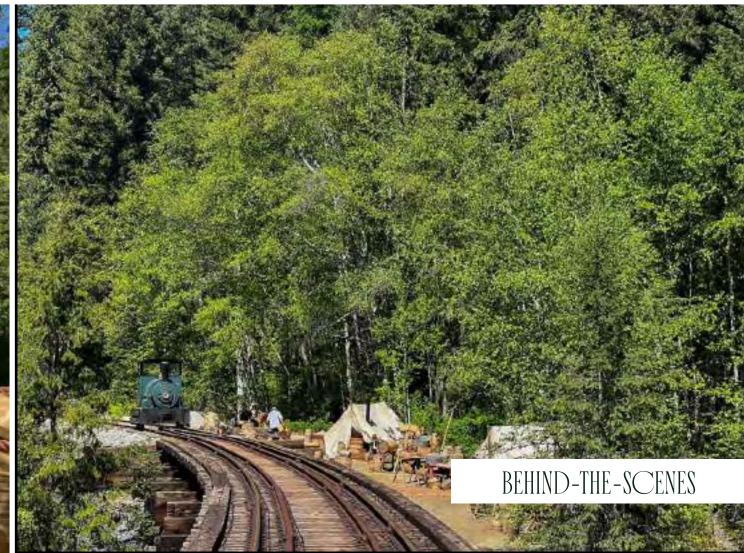














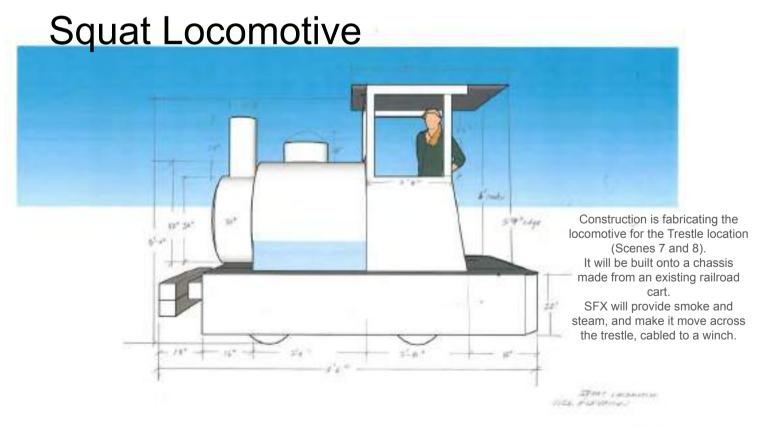
Squat Locomotive

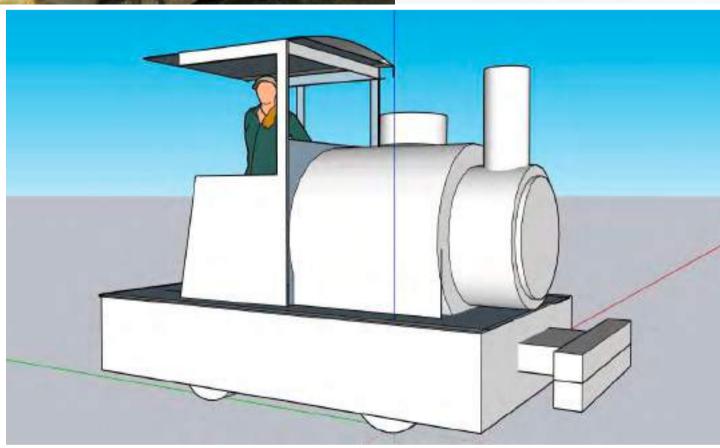
The locomotive is designed to be a combination of existing period locomotives.

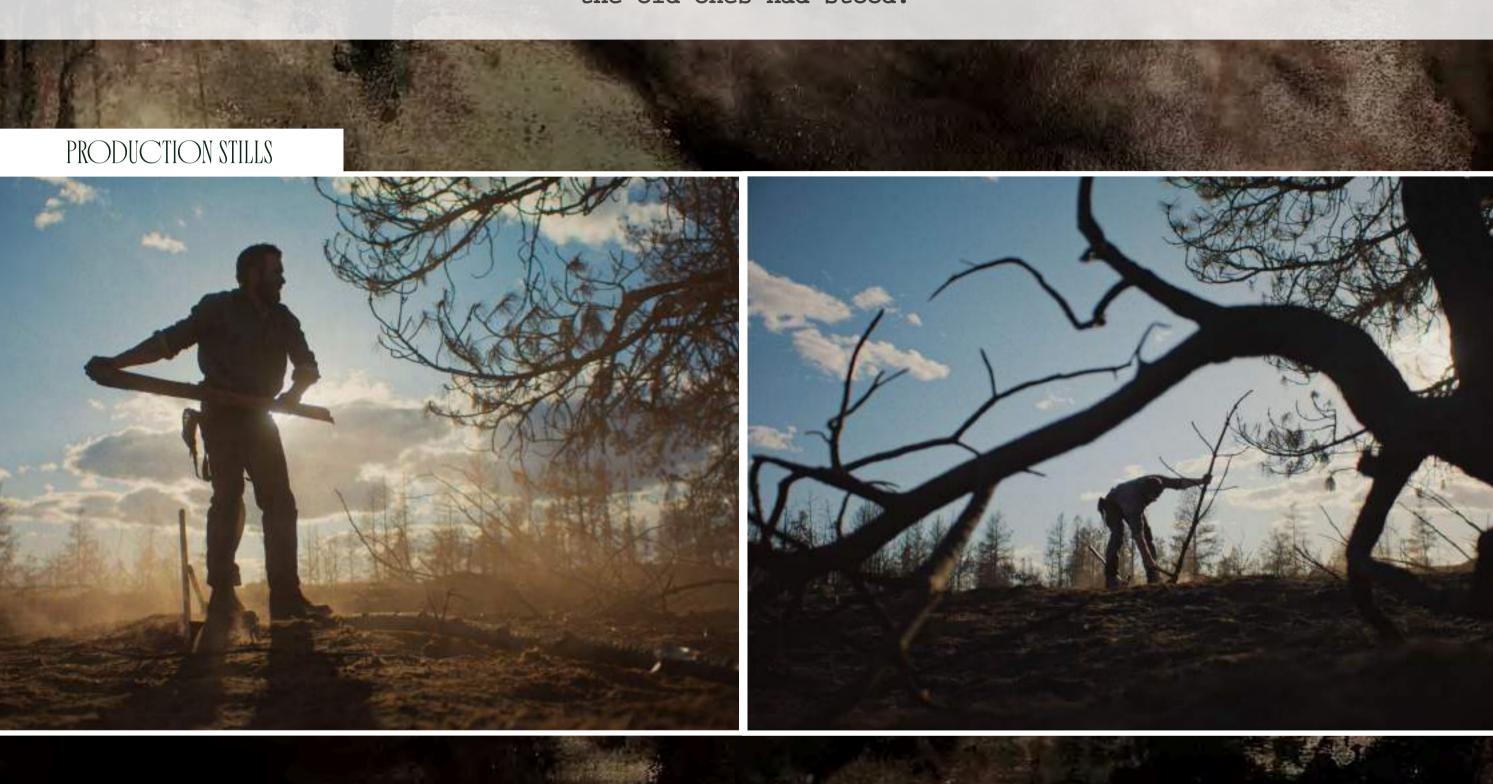
EXT. GRAINIER'S ACRE, BURNT SITE / LEAN-TO, 1920'S - DAY

Grainier has busted down some skinny trees and is building a rude LEAN-TO with the blackened trees where his cabin once was.

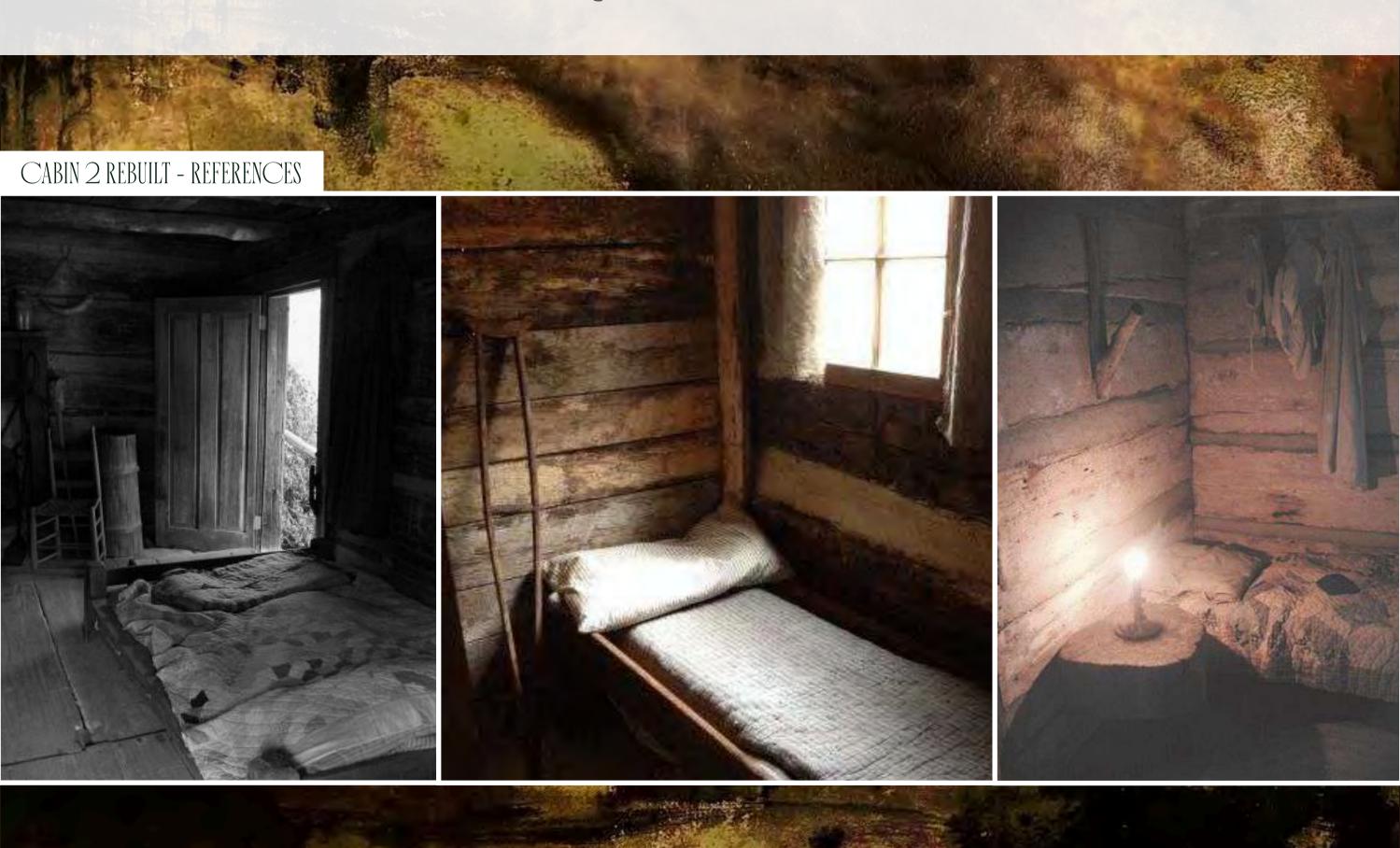




With Ignatius Jack's help, he raised the four walls of the cabin precisely where the old ones had stood.



He could not bring himself to rebuild the bedroom.

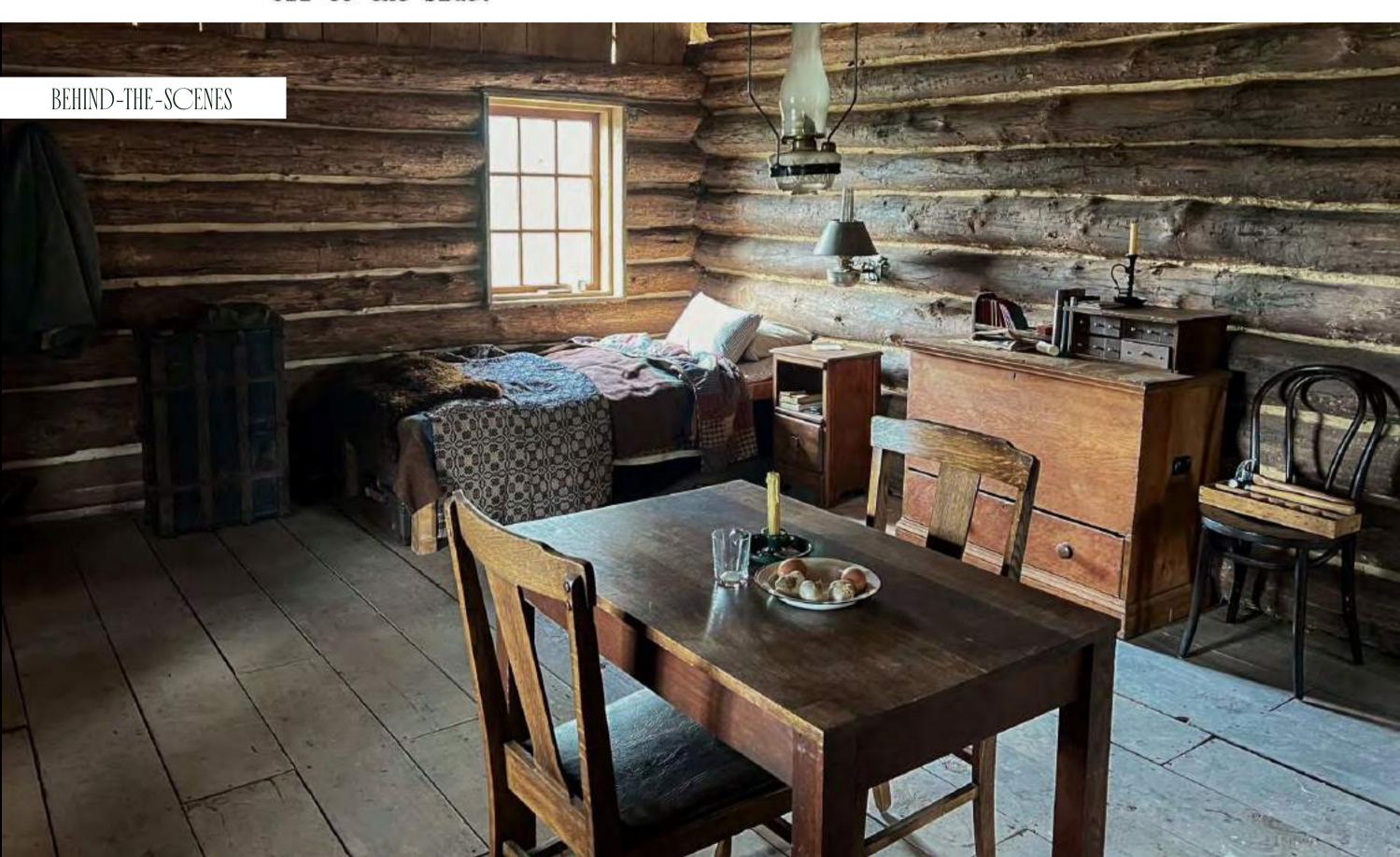






INT. GRAINIER'S ACRE / CABIN 2, AUTUMN, 1968 - AFTERNOON 2

Not much inside the cabin. A stove. A table and chair. A BED off to the side.









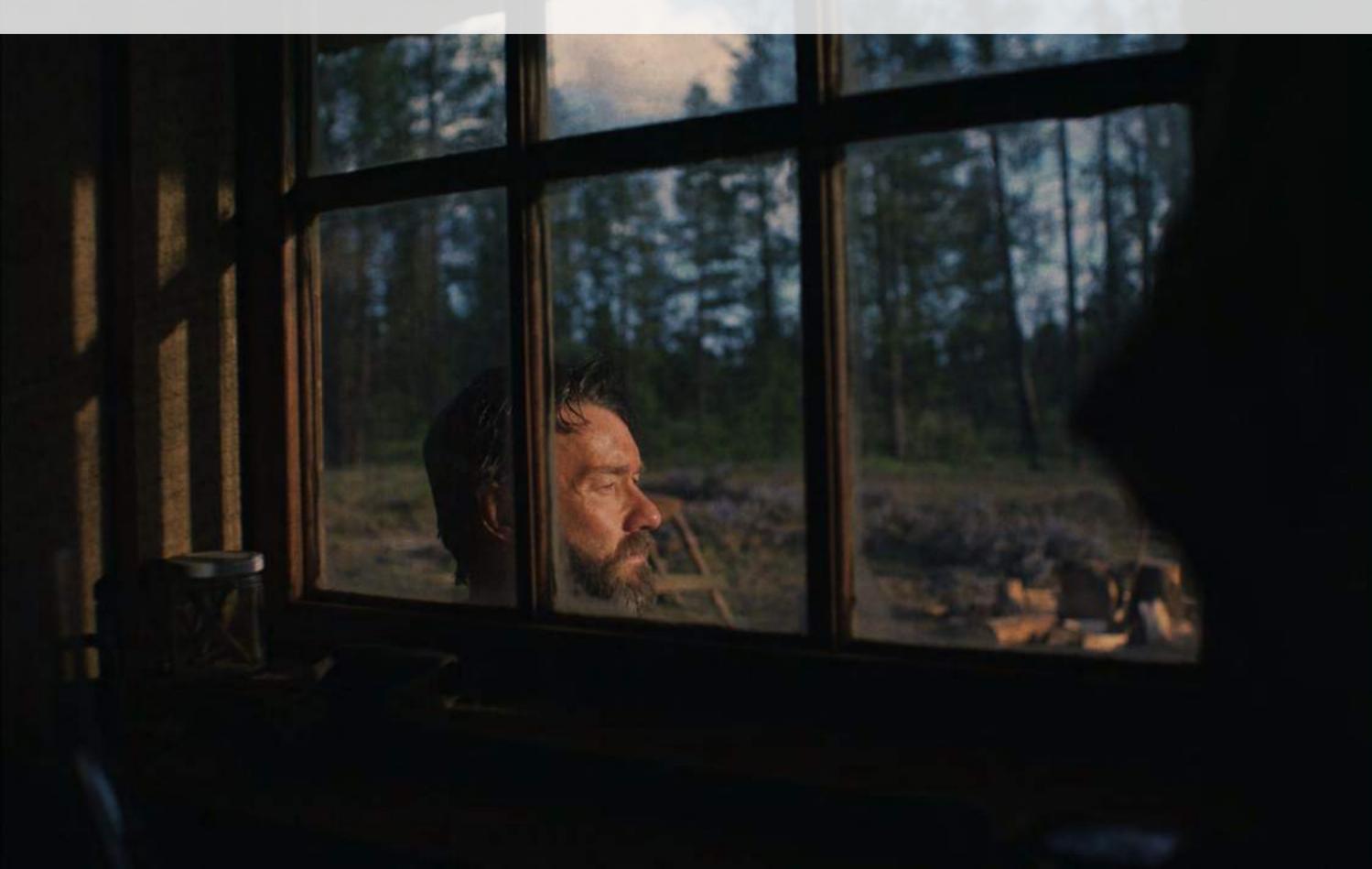

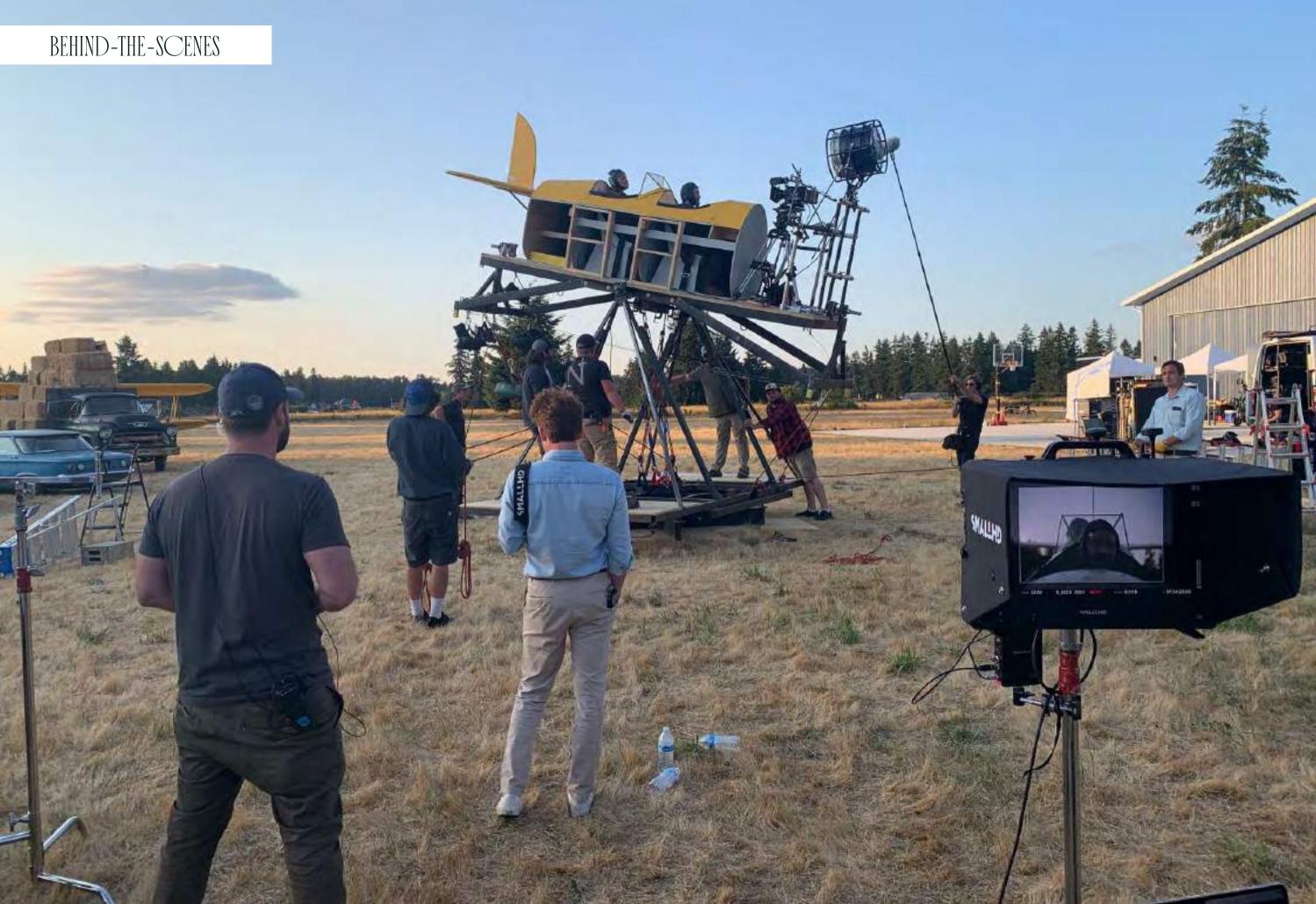
Clouds roll by. The world below is very small.

And all the mysteries of this life are answered.





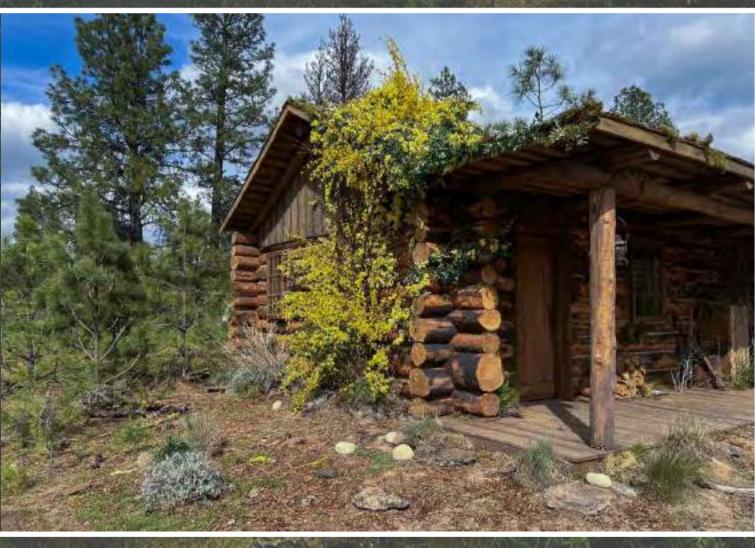

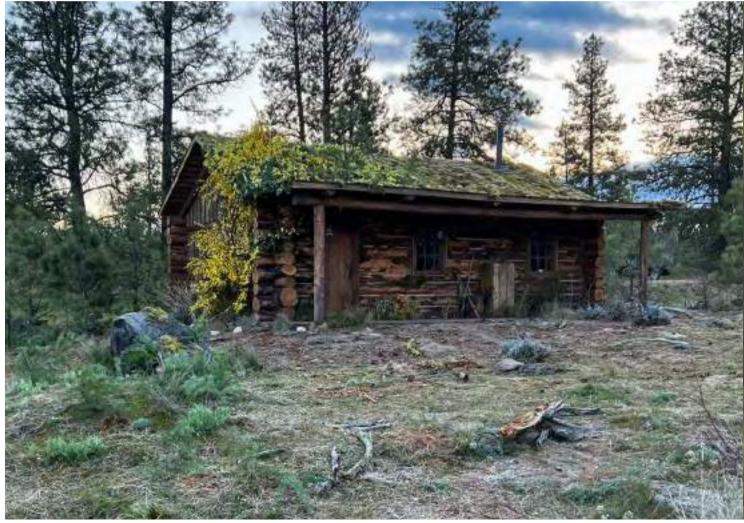
