
A LOT OF WORK WAS DONE IN THIS SPACE. WE ADDED:


LOCATION WORK- INT RANCH HOUSE








TILTED ROOM




THE WHOLE SET WAS BUILT ON STEEL DECK WE HAD TO BE VERY CAREFUL ABOUT THE 3-4" DEPTH OF THE "LID" THAT LAID FLAT- SO MAKE SURE THE WHOLE FLOOR WAS ONE LEVEL FOR SABRINA TO EASILY DANCE.

SPECIAL EFFECTS WERE AMAZING AND GOT THE WHOLE DOOR RIGGED FOR US USING TRUSS AROUND THE SIDE AND RUNNING CABLE THROUGH PULLEYS. TO COMPENSATE FOR THE INCREDIBLE WEIGHT- WE RIGGED THE PULLEYS TO SFX'S TRUCK AND MOVED IT FORWARD AND BACKWARD TO LOWER OR RAISE.


































WE HAD TO ROUGH OUT OUR PLANS DUE TO SPEED. BUT THEY WORKED GREAT!
