AFTER THE HUNT - ADG AWARDS

Directed by Luca Guadagnino | Amazon MGM Studios

After the Hunt required the construction of an academic world where intellectual order coexists with emotional and ethical fracture.

The production design approach was to translate this tension into physical space, creating environments that feel authentic, inhabited, and rooted in contemporary Yale, while always filtered through the psychology of the characters rather than through literal reproduction.

From the earliest conversations, Luca Guadagnino provided a set of visual and cinematic references that defined the tone and discipline of the world. Our shared goal was to build a precise, coherent spatial system: institutional where needed, domestic where intimate, and always aligned with the internal states of the characters and what they seek to represent. The design aimed to reflect structure and instability simultaneously, allowing the sets to participate in the film's moral and emotional rhythm.

The majority of the film was built at Shepperton Studios. We constructed Alma and Frederik's apartment, Alma's Wharf loft, the main quad, the Beinecke Library and its plaza, the Tandoor restaurant, and accurate reconstructions of several New Haven interiors, including the Three Sheets Bar, a pharmacy, a liquor store, a Yale Department of Mental Health office, and a hospital room. Only a handful of small exterior moments were shot at Cambridge University, chosen for architectural affinities capable of suggesting Yale without directly replicating it.

Alma and Frederik's apartment was designed as a multi-layered domestic portrait shaped by three imagined generations. The grandparents introduced European Bauhaus and Wiener Werkstätte influences; the "Kennedy domestic era" brought mid-century American refinement shaped by Jacqueline Kennedy and Lee Radziwill; and the contemporary layer reflects Alma and Frederik's own intellectual and cosmopolitan identities. The result is an apartment that feels inherited yet distinctly self-authored, a space that carries privilege, culture, and restraint.

Alma's Wharf apartment is defined by subtraction. Stripped down, functional, and industrial, it removes history and removes performance. It operates as a mental space rather than a social one, offering a counterpoint to the layered and inherited world of the main apartment. The absence of ornament is treated as a design principle, allowing clarity, exposure, and emotional truth to emerge through the architecture.

After the Hunt is structured through its spaces: each room is built to hold duality, intellect and instinct, order and collapse, the visible and the hidden, power as a form of self-assertion in society and power as embodied by the institution. Achieving this required a combination of architectural precision, rigorous research, and intuitive character-based design.

Constructing a cohesive and highly detailed environment within a limited timeframe was possible thanks to the strength of the art department and set decoration team led by Lee Sandales. The collaboration with cinematographer Malik Hassan Sayeed and VFX Supervisor Fabio Cerrito ensured that the physical and digital worlds merged seamlessly, allowing us to recreate a geographically and emotionally convincing Yale entirely in London, reaching such precision and realism.
