DESIGN CONCEPT

Perception shapes reality; my visual approach renders Linda's fractured inner world through precise detail and a palette of red-orange, sepia, rust, sickly greens, and bruised violets set against cool interiors.

These contrasts echo a cyclical, life-death rhythm. The hole appears as a collapsed spiral, a visual loop mirroring the recurrence of her psychosis. As Linda turns inward, the external world begins to reflect her internal unraveling. Like holotropic breath or the pulsation of child's machine, the hole becomes a portal to awakening. Opening into a void: a liminal space of darkness with drifting light that suggest both rupture and possibility.

Though seemingly vast, I wanted to explore the void existing entirely within her body and mind. We built these environments through macro, practical superimpositions.

Materiality was essential in transforming the flooded bedroom into a living organism. Water, dust, insulation, and fibrous textures generate an atmosphere that feels tactile and organic.

Fabric once grounded as laundry rises into diaphanous forms, suspended in the void. Using classic practical effects, puppetry, miniature builds, and layered textures, we give the hole a fleshy, evolving presence. Circular and hypnotic forms in both structure and color that guide the viewer deeper into Linda's psyche. The ceiling hole and the child's stomach become subconscious anchors in our visual motif, marking the points around which Linda's reality begins to dissolve.

James represents the connection Linda longs for but cannot access. His environment is more saturated and alive, reflecting, and at times mocking, the emotional engagement she lacks in her isolation.


